An outstanding member of the media and an outstanding law enforcement coordinator will be honored that night.

This year's conference will have several unique training sessions throughout the weekend including "Collaborative Fugitive Apprehension" presented by a team of Special Agents of the US Marshal's Service. And "Terrorist Awareness and Identification" presented by FBI Special Agent Andrew Bringuel of the bureau's Behavioral Analysis Unit located in Quantico, Virginia.

The conference is hosted by the Isle of Wight, Smithfield, Windsor Crime Line and is proudly sponsored by WTKR NewsChannel 3. WTKR has created a successful partnership with Hampton Roads Crime Line for its weekly "Taking Action Against Crime" segment. 63 fugitives have been caught so far.
