The NBC affiliate earned five regional Emmys, leading all Hampton Roads stations in Emmy wins at the awards dinner for the National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.

10 On Your Side's Tom Schaad and Photojournalist Colin McIntyre won three Emmys for their brilliant work on "Monarch Marching Madness", their Sports-News Story "Johnny JackRabbit Brown" and for their sports news series "The Monarch's Zone".

"Johnny 'Jackrabbit' Brown was such an amazing interview and Colin McIntyre's work on that series was incredible," said WAVY News 10 Anchor Tom Schaad. "He had the understanding and vision of the story we wanted to tell. That's the kind of people we have at WAVY."

The Sportwrap's Chris Reckling along with Photojournalists Matt Mrozinski, Andy Miller and Colin McIntyre took home the Emmy for best sports feature with their riveting story, "A Moment I'll Never Forget".

"Our photojournalists worked really hard this year individually, and as a team," said Chief Photographer Jeff Myers. "It is great to be recognized by the Emmys - to be among the best in our business! This is a very proud moment for my photography staff and for WAVY TV 10 and FOX 43."

Reporter Oren Liebermann and Photojournalist Colin McIntyre also won an Emmy for best general assignment report within 24 hours.
