WAVY-TV 10 Teams Up with Eagle 97 for Eagle Walk 2012

Eagle Walk kicks off on Wednesday, April 25 in James City County. The 70-mile walk will conclude at 24th Street at the Virginia Beach Oceanfront on Sunday, April 29th. Then, the March for Babies walk kicks off at 9 am!

Our walk sounds daunting, but it is nothing compared to the physical and emotional journey countless families face because of birth defect or premature delivery," said WAVY-TV 10 Anchor Kerri Furey. The 70-mile Eagle Walk route includes the following stops:



<u>Wednesday, April 25:</u> (7 am-11 am) Eagle Walk begins in James City County on Route 143 and travels down into Newport News (at Rte 143 and 64 intersection), ending at LFCU City Center.



<u>Thursday, April 26:</u> (6 am-10:30 am) The walk continues at Patrick Henry Mall in Newport News, enters York County, then proceeds to Hampton and ends the day at Warwick Blvd at the Mercury Blvd overpass.



<u>Friday, April 27:</u> (6 am-3 pm) Eagle Walk makes its way to the Isle of Wight side of the James River Bridge, enters Suffolk and moves on to Chesapeake around the 664 intersection. The walk continues after a 2 hour break and travels down Route 17 and enters Portsmouth (stops at weigh station at the Midtown Tunnel).



<u>Saturday, April 28:</u> (9 am-11:30 am) Kerri and Jimmy Ray begin in Norfolk across from Sentara Norfolk Hospital and then march toward Virginia Beach Blvd to Rosemont Rd.



<u>Sunday, April 29:</u> (6 am-8 am) Eagle Walk concludes on Virginia Beach Blvd at Princess Anne Plaza as March for Babies begins at the VA Beach Oceanfront.
