# Local Radio Station to Change Dial Position and Receive Signal Upgrade

WDYL-FM Y101 to change its position on the radio dial July 17th

**RICHMOND, VA – June 15, 2009** – WDYL-FM Y101, Richmond's New Rock Alternative, announced today that its frequency will officially change from 101.1 FM to 100.9 FM, on July 17<sup>th</sup> at 2pm.

The dial position change will be in conjunction with the transition to a new tower. The new tower will provide a boost in the broadcast power of WDYL-FM Y101 by more than 4 times, by broadcasting at a total of 15,000 watts. The station will also transmit in full HD Radio.

Y101's format and programming will remain the same after the transition. The on air line up includes: **top syndicated morning show**: Bubba The Love Sponge® - 6am-10am **Live and Local talent:** Angie – 10am-2pm, The Sludge Nation – 2pm-6m and Twitch – 6pm-11pm.
