## COLONIAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION SPEADS ITS BROADCASTING ARMS WITH RENEWED RADIO PARTNERSHIP

Richmond, VA – ESPN 950 WXGI announced today that for the eighth consecutive year it will provide radio coverage of all eleven games at the Colonial Athletic Association Men's Basketball Tournament, March 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>, from the Richmond Coliseum. This year, the four days of broadcast will be featured on-air, online and via multiple mobile apps.

The worldwide coverage will begin Friday, Saturday at 11:55a.m., Sunday at 1:55p.m with the championship game broadcast starting at 6:55 on Monday night on ESPN 950. . ESPN 950 will also be on-site for live broadcasts outside of the Coliseum Saturday and Sunday.
