The annual 70 mile walk across Hampton Roads finishes at the Virginia Beach Oceanfront on May 1st.

- Wednesday, April 27th: Eagle Walk begins at 7am at the Williamsburg Country Club in James City County ending at Langley Federal Credit Union Oyster Point in Newport News. There will be a meet and greet there until 1 pm.
- Thursday, April 28th: Eagle Walk continues at 6 am at Patrick Henry Mall and ends at Langley Federal Credit Union at 11 am. There will be a meet and greet there until 1pm.
- Friday, April 29th: Eagle Walk continues at 6 am at the shopping center, two miles south of the James River Bridge, in Isle of Wight County. They will stop at 11 am at Hall Chevrolet in Western Branch for a meet and greet until 1 pm.
- Saturday, April 30th: Eagle Walk continues at 9 am on the Norfolk side of the Midtown Tunnel, on Brambleton Avenue across from Sentara Norfolk Hospital. They will walk to Rosemont Road in Virginia Beach until 11:30 am.
- Sunday, May 1st: Eagle Walk wraps up at 6am at the Denny's on Virginia Beach Blvd. Kerri and Jimmy Ray will walk to the 24th Street Park at the Oceanfront to join the March for Babies walk which kicks off at 9 am.
